BULK PICK-UP is May 1st!!

Please have your household bulk items curbside Sunday May 1st. Trucks will be in our Village beginning May 2nd, once the truck has completed your street, it will not return.

BULK ITEMS INCLUDE:

White goods, appliances, furniture, gas grills (no tanks), hot water heaters, lawn chairs, Rugs (4ft in length, rolled & tied). Freon must be Removed from refrigerators (doors removed), freezers and air conditioners before pick-up & tagged by a professional.

DO NOT PUT OUT:

Construction/renovation/demolition material, (wood, toilet, sink, bathtub, Cabinets, etc.), hazardous waste, yard debris, tires, gas tanks, fencing & metal.

HOMEOWNERS ARE RE-QUIRED TO TAKE THE FOL-LOWING ITEMS TO THE TRANSFER STATION:

Electronic equipment (TVs, Computers, Monitors, CPUs, Printers)
