Our Village Code is available online at www.VillageofWalden.org and http://www.ecode360.com/WA0823. The purpose of Property Maintenance Ordinances are to protect the properties in residential and commercial neighborhoods by establishing minimum maintenance standards that are designed to maintain or increase property values, housing prices, quality of life. Excerpted from Village Code Section 247.9

E. All garbage and trash shall be placed at or within three feet of the curb or public street line for collection no earlier than 5:00 p.m. nor later than 11:00 p.m. on the day before collection.

[Amended 6-12-2007 by L.L. No. 3-2007]

<u>F.</u> All containers shall be removed from the curb or street and to a place invisible from the street by 9:00 p.m. on the day of collection.
