

Halloween Safety Tips

- 1. Avoid Trick—or—Treating alone. Walk in groups or with a trusted adult.
- 2. Fasten reflective tape to costumes and bags to help drivers see you.
- 3. Examine all treats for choking hazards and tampering before eating them.
- 4. Hold a flashlight while Trick or Treating to help you see and others see you.
- 5. Look both ways before crossing the street.
- 6. Wear well—fitting masks, costumes, and shoes to avoid blocked vision, trips, and falls.
- 7. Eat only factory wrapped treats
- 8. Enter homes only if you're with a trusted adult. Don't stop at dark houses. Never accept rides from strangers.
- 9. Only walk on sidewalks whenever possible, or on the far edge of the road facing traffic to stay safe. Never RUN from house to house.

Hard to believe that winter is upon us, but please be aware of the Village's SNOW EMERGENCY PROCEDURES

It shall be unlawful for any person to park, place or leave their automobile, truck or any other vehicle on any public road or street in the Village of Walden after snowfall of 2 inches or more of snow. **Yehicles will be ticketed and towed at owners' expense.** Snow emergencies will remain in effect until snowfall has ceased and all snow has been removed from public streets.

It shall be the duty of the owner and occupant, jointly, of every parcel of real estate adjoining a public sidewalk, to keep such sidewalks adjoining such property free from snow and ice for the <u>full width of such sidewalk or for minimum width of four feet</u>, whichever is less.

Owners and occupants of corner properties shall have additional and continual duty to clear snow and ice from the sidewalks to the curbs for a minimum of four feet so as to provide safe access to the streets.

Snow and ice shall be removed within 24 hours after the end of a snowfall.
