New to Walden and want to become an eligible registered Village of Walden voter? You must register with the Orange County Board of Elections no later than **Friday, March 10, 2017**

Need an Absentee Ballot? Want one mailed to you prior to the election? Your absentee ballot application must be returned to the Village Clerk's office no later than **Tuesday, March 14, 2017** to meet the mailing deadline. After this deadline you can still apply for an absentee ballot in person and will receive an absentee ballot on the spot that must be returned to the Village Clerk's office between **March 15th and March 20th**

Absentee ballot applications are available at Village Hall on the 3rd floor in the document holder next to our office doors or on our website www.villageofwalden.org in the center of our homepage.

In local government your voice can be heard the loudest, so get out and vote!



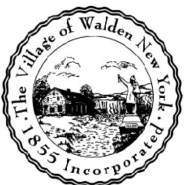

SNOW STORM PROCEDURES

It shall be unlawful for any person to park, place or leave their automobile, truck or any other vehicle on any public road or street in the Village of Walden after snowfall of 2 inches or more. **Vehicles will be ticketed and towed at owners' expense.** Snow parking policy will remain in effect until snowfall has ceased and all snow has been removed from public streets.

It shall be the duty of the owner and occupant, jointly, of every parcel of real estate adjoining a public sidewalk, to keep such sidewalks adjoining such property free from snow and ice for the **full width of such sidewalk or for minimum width of four feet,** whichever is less. Owners and occupants of corner properties shall have additional and continual duty to clear snow and ice from the sidewalks to the curbs for a minimum of four feet so as to provide safe access to the streets.

Snow and ice shall be removed within 24 hours after the end of a snow parking policy period.

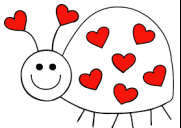
