Village of Walden Residential Garbage Customers...

(commercial refuse customers are not included in residential bulk pick up)

Please have your household bulk items curbside on Sunday, October 22, 2017.

Trucks will be going through our Village from October 23 - October 27, 2017 with all items picked up by Friday, October 27th.

Once the truck has completed your street, it will NOT return.

BULK ITEMS INCLUDE: Appliances (please note: refrigerators, freezers and air conditioners **MUST** have Freon removed before pickup & be tagged by a professional and the doors need to be removed), furniture, hot water heaters, gas grills (no tanks), lawn chairs, and Rugs (must be rolled & tied in 4ft lengths).

DO NOT PUT OUT: Construction/renovation/demolition materials (ie: wood, toilets, sinks, bathtubs, cabinets, paint cans, etc.), hazardous waste, yard debris, tires, gas tanks, or fencing & metal, or electronic equipment** (TV's, Computers, Monitors, CPU's, Printers, etc.). (Please be advised that these items will **NOT** be picked up & if left curbside after the truck has gone down your street, you may be subject to a violation of Village Code)

**Please be advised that printers, fax machines, computer monitors and towers, scanners, small servers, cables/wires, laptops, cell and smart phones, tablets, video game consoles, DVD players, VCR's, and digital music players can be brought to the Orange County Transfer Stations as they will now accept these items free of charge. Televisions will also be accepted at a rate of \$5 per unit with no restriction on size. Small appliances, microwaves and vacuum cleaners will not be accepted. **

RESIDENT'S WINTER WEATHER RESPONSIBILITIES

It shall be unlawful for any person to park, place or leave their automobile, truck or any other vehicle on any public road or street in the Village of Walden after snowfall of 2 inches or more of snow. Vehicles will be ticketed and towed at owners' expense. Snow parking rules will remain in effect until snowfall has ceased and all snow has been removed from public streets.

It shall be the duty of the owner and occupant, jointly, of every parcel of real estate adjoining a public sidewalk, to keep such sidewalks adjoining such property free from snow and ice for the full width of such sidewalk or for minimum width of four feet, whichever is less. Owners and occupants of corner properties shall have additional and continual duty to clear snow and ice from the sidewalks to the curbs for a minimum of four feet so as to provide safe access to the streets.

Snow and ice shall be removed within 24 hours after the end of a snowfall.

Please be sure to check the Village website (www.villageofwalden.org) for the time that the snow parking police has been lifted or call our hotline at 845-778-4919 so you know when all snow has been removed from public streets.

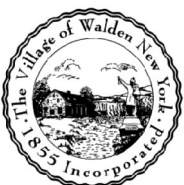

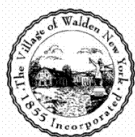
