LOCAL LAW 7 OF 2019

A LOCAL LAW AMENDING CHAPTER 305 OF THE CODE OF THE VILLAGE OF WALDEN ENTITLED "ZONING" TO THE EXTENT OF ADDING A NEW SECTION DESIGNATED AS SECTION 305-41.2 ENTITLED "PROHIBITED SIGNS."

BE IT ENACTED by the Village Board of the Village of Walden as follows:

SECTION 1 - TITLE

This Local Law shall be referred to as "A Local Law Amending Chapter 305 of the Code of the Village of Walden entitled "Zoning" to the extent of adding a new Section designated as Section 305-41.2 entitled "Prohibited Signs."

SECTION 2 – PURPOSE & INTENT

The purpose of this Local Law is to designate certain specific, limited, Village-owned parkland wherein all signage shall be expressly prohibited.

SECTION 3 – AMENDMENT TO CHAPTER 305 TO BE DESIGNATED AS SECTION 305-41.2. The Zoning Ordinance of the Village of Walden is hereby amended by the addition of Section 305-41.2 and shall provide as follows:

Section 305-41.2. Prohibited Signs.

- a. Signs of any kind, including but not limited to all signs that are defined in Section 305-3 of the Code of the Village of Walden, are prohibited in the Village-owned parks known and designated as Firemen's Triangle Park located at Scofield Street and Orchard Street and McKinley Monument Park located at Orange Avenue and East Main Street.
- b. The placement of a sign or signs in violation of this provision shall be punishable by the imposition of a fine in an amount not to exceed \$250.00.

SECTION 4 - VALIDITY

If any clause, sentence, paragraph, word, section or part of this local law shall be adjudged by any court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, such judgment shall not affect, impair or invalidate the remainder thereof, but shall be

confined in its operation to the clause, sentence, paragraph, word, section or part thereof directly involved in the controversy in which such judgment shall have been rendered.

SECTION 5- EFFECTIVE DATE

This Local Law shall take effect immediately when it is filed in the Office of the New York State Secretary of State in accordance with Section 27 of the Municipal Home Rule Law.
