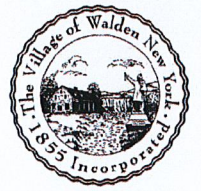

SEMI-ANNUAL HYDRANT FLUSHING

THE VILLAGE OF WALDEN WILL BE DOING THE SEMI-ANNUAL FLUSHING OF FIRE HYDRANTS DURING THE ENTIRE MONTH OF APRIL

YOUR WATER MAY BE DISCOLORED, BUT IT WILL BE SAFE TO DRINK.

PLEASE CONSIDER WAITING UNTIL AFTER 6PM TO DO LAUNDRY. TO AVOID DISCOLORED WATER IN YOUR RESIDENCE PLEASE ATTEMPT TO USE AS LITTLE WATER AS POSSIBLE DURING THE FLUSHING HOURS.

There may be reduced pressure at times due to water flow and closing of valves throughout the distribution system. We apologize for any inconvenience, but this is necessary to remove debris that naturally accumulates in the mains.



Yard Waste Pick-Up Resumes Thursdays, Beginning April 2nd through November (or later, weather permitting)

Yard waste clippings (grass/leaves) may be put in Paper Lawn Bags or in regular garbage cans with the lids left off so the garbage company can clearly see it is yard waste in the can. Any sticks or branches must be bundled together in no more than 4 foot lengths. Items should go out Wednesday evenings for Thursday morning pick up.

No Wipes Down the Pipes

Even if a product says it is "flushable" ...
Unless it is toilet paper, it should not be flushed!

- Diapers (including cloth, cotton, disposable, or plastic)
- Flushable, disposable, cleaning, or baby wipes
- Paper towels, cloth towels, or any type of rag
- Feminine hygiene products
- Facial Tissues

Putting these items down toilets may plug sewers and cause raw sewage to back up into YOUR HOME

BULK PICK UP DETAILS:

Village of Walden Residential Garbage Customers...

Please have your household bulk items curbside on **Sunday, April 26, 2020**. Trucks will be going through our Village from April 26 - May 1, 2020 with all items picked up by Friday, May 1st.

Once the truck has completed your street, it will NOT return.

BULK ITEMS INCLUDE:

Appliances, furniture, hot water heaters, gas grills (no tanks), lawn chairs, Rugs (4ft in length, rolled & tied). Freon **MUST** be removed before pickup & tagged by a professional for all refrigerators, freezers and air conditioners (doors need to be removed as well).

DO NOT PUT OUT: Construction/renovation/demolition materials (ie: wood, toilets, sinks, bathtubs, doors, windows, cabinets, paint cans, etc.), hazardous waste, yard debris, tires, gas tanks, or fencing & metal, or electronic equipment (ie: TV's, Computers, Monitors, CPU's, Printers, etc.).

(Please be advised that these items will NOT be picked up & if left curbside after the truck has gone down your street, you will be subject to a violation of Village Code)

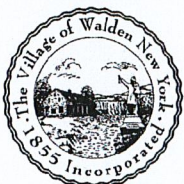
